

Key to genus *XANTHOGRAMMA*

Schiner, 1860

1a Spots on tergite 2 narrow and often triangular (Fig. 409). Legs orange.

Xanthogramma citrofasciatum (De Geer, 1776)

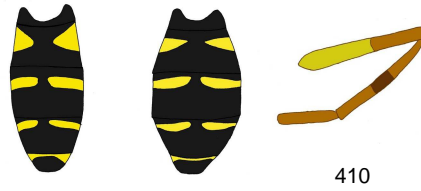
1b Spots on tergite 2 broad and triangular (Fig. 15). Apical part of hind femur dark and hind tibia with a dark ring (Fig. 410). → 2

2a Wing with the dark area below stigma continuing distinctly below radial vein R_{2+3} (Fig. 706). Abdominal membrane between tergites and sternites dark at point of posterior part of sternites 2-4 (Fig. 707).

Xanthogramma pedissequum (Harris, 1776)

2b Wing with the dark area below stigma ending at radial vein R_{2+3} (Fig. 708). Abdominal membrane between tergites and sternites dark only at point of posterior part of sternite 2 (Fig. 709). If yellow membrane has dried and got attached to dark tergite, it may seem darker.
